CRITERIA FOR GRADUATE LECTURER APPOINTMENT

1. Hold the terminal degree normally accepted for academic employment in the discipline or have achieved some extraordinary accomplishment as determined by the Graduate Committee of the nominee's department, school or interdepartmental area.
2. Have completed at least two years of work experience relevant to the discipline to be taught. This may include teaching, research, clinical or other professional experience.

CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT

1. Graduate Lecturers may be appointed for a period up to four years, with the option for renewal.
2. Graduate Lecturer appointment permits teaching of only the course(s) for which the individual is approved. If a change in course assignment is desired, a new request form must be submitted.
3. Graduate Lecturers are not members of the Graduate Faculty and, therefore, do not have the full authority and responsibilities of Graduate Faculty as defined in the *Graduate College Policy Handbook (June 2018)*.
