- 2. Have completed at least two years of work experience relevant to the discipline to be taught. This may include teaching, research, clinical or other professional experience.

- 3. Graduate Lecturers are not members of the Graduate Faculty and, therefore, do not have the full authority and responsibilities of Graduate Faculty as defined in the *Graduate College Policy Handbook (June 2018)*.
